President McDonald led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment

President McDonald welcomed Dan DeMeno to his first meeting as our new Borough manager.

There was no public comment.

Old Business/Committee Reports/Zoning Applications

Member Sando had suggested to Members McDonald and Hart that we ask the manager to send a letter to our legislators stating that we passed a Resolution opposing the legislation on non-profits. Solicitor Gifford said in addition to the letter send them a copy of the Resolution.

FINANCE COMMITTEE: Member Hart said she has asked the manager to start looking at interest rates for financing our capital improvements.

Manager DeMeno said Septa is going before the Zoning Hearing Board in April for the parking lot. The meeting will be April 7th. Solicitor Gifford said Council did not have the express authority to grant variances. Therefore, Council should send a letter to the Zoning Board informing them that Council has already approved the changes and voted to grant the waivers requested.

Andrew Berenson, 439 Washington Avenue, asked Solicitor Gifford if he would be working with Council to amend the Borough Codes to allow for this procedure. Solicitor Gifford said this would be put on the agenda at a later date. It is a good idea to have it.

Solicitor / Mayor / Council / Manager

Solicitor Gifford said he has two matters for executive session both of which pertain to personnel with no action required.

Member Tarlecki asked when the auditors would be coming to report to Council. Manager DeMeno said he has spoken to them and they will be setting a date soon.

Member Hart commended public works for the good job they did with the last snow storm. Member Scott asked if there were a lot of complaints. Manager DeMeno said he received a few calls saying they did a good job. There was one complaint but it was for Upper Gwynedd. Solicitor Gifford said as a matter of public interest coming out of Philadelphia on Broad Street it's not a pot hole but a crater so be careful.

Member Redstreak formally announced that he is not running for reelection. He is certain there will be a vested individual to take his place.

Member Cherry said at the Park and Recreation meeting this Thursday, they will be discussing trees for Main Street and have a plan in place for next month.

President McDonald said public works did do a great job.

Member Hart made a motion to adjourn. Member Scott seconded the motion. Motion passed 9 yes, 0 no. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 PM.
