§ 17-1. Agency established.

The Borough of North Wales Emergency Management Agency is hereby established.

§ 17-2. Membership.

The members of the Borough of North Wales Emergency Management Agency shall consist of all of the elected and appointed officials of the borough, all employees of the borough and any volunteer (provided that such volunteer has been appointed by the Local Coordinator of the Emergency Management Agency).

§ 17-3. Recommendation and appointment of Local Coordinators.

The Borough Council is authorized to recommend two (2) individuals to the Governor for appointment as Local

Coordinator of Emergency Management and Deputy Local
Coordinator of Emergency Management.

§ 17-4. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of any disaster emergency management plan which has been approved by Borough Council pursuant to the Emergency Management Services Code, Active Assembly, November 26, 1978, P.L. 1332, No. 323 (35 Pa.C.S.A., § 7101 et seq.) shall, for each and every such violation, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than one thousand (\$1,000.), plus the costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment thereof, to imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days; provided, however, that each day's violation of any provision of such plan constitute a separate violation thereof.
