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# Get Your 2026 Parking Permit!

Starting November 1st, 2025, if you reside in the Permit Parking Zone, parking permits are required! If you do not have a parking permit already, please submit your application for permit parking by **January 31**.

Applications for a new or replacement parking permit can be made online or in-person at Borough Hall. Applicants must provide a driver's license and vehicle registration reflecting the Borough property address for which they are applying. Parking passes will be granted **free of charge**.



## **Do I need to renew my parking pass?**

As of 2023, permanent resident (homeowner) parking passes do not expire and do not need to be renewed unless the resident purchases a new vehicle, changes residences, or transfers property ownership. Those renting in the Borough will need to obtain parking passes every year.

## **Are residential parking permits available to renters?**

Yes! When applying, renters must provide an updated driver's license, vehicle registration showing that their property address is within North Wales Borough, and a copy of their rental agreement.

## **When will I receive my permit?**

Please allow 5-7 business days for delivery of your parking sticker if you apply online. In person, applications are typically fulfilled at the time of application, assuming proper proof of residency is accompanied with the application.

## **Where do I display my permit?**

The sticker shall be placed on the rear window of the vehicle. While most streets shall place the permit on the driver's-side rear window, residents of Fifth, Fourth, and Second Street shall place their stickers on the passenger-side rear window.

## **ECode 360**

Do you have questions about the laws, ordinances, and regulations that guide your experience here in North Wales? The Borough of North Wales is excited to introduce ECode360, a software our residents can use to access our governing codes.

Following the footsteps of many other local municipalities, this technology has made our code more accessible than ever. From Zoning to Parks and Recreation, it's important to us that our residents can read our code from any device, anywhere!



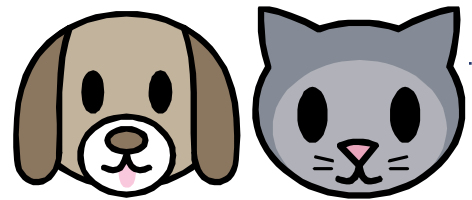

## Clean Up After Your Pet

Did you know that pet waste contains bacteria that makes our waterways unsafe for swimming and other recreational activities? Most of us pick up after our pets to be good neighbors and keep our yards clean. But there's another important reason to clean up after our pets: pet waste contains bacteria that is harmful to our water.



An average size dog dropping contains 3 billion fecal coliform bacteria and other pathogens that could be a health hazard! Leaving it on the sidewalk or in the yards means that harmful bacteria can get washed into storm drains and roadside ditches that flow directly into our lakes and rivers untreated. Noting that 40% of households have a dog, you can imagine the potential problems if all, or even a portion of that amount of waste ended up in our surface waters that are being used for recreational and other purposes.

**So, what can you do? Simple. Whether you are in your yard or on a walk, dispose of your pet's waste promptly in the trash or toilet to prevent it from entering storm drains and roadside ditches. Pick up after your pet...and help keep our water clean.**

# Snowstorm Frequently Asked Questions

## **Which roads are plowed first?**

Plow routes are determined by a priority system established by the Borough.

## **What responsibilities do I have as a homeowner to clear snow?**

Per Ordinance 181-14, all homeowners and occupants of properties are responsible for clearing all snow and ice on all sidewalks in front of and alongside the property. This snow and ice must be removed within 24 hours of accumulation. Alleyways are also a source of confusion among Borough residents. Alleys belong to the abutting property owner and are therefore the responsibility of owners and/or occupants of the property to clear of snow and ice.

## **Why do plows push snow back onto my shoveled sidewalk and driveway?**

During and after snowfalls, Borough crews will be out clearing the roads at the same time residents are clearing their sidewalks and driveways. Sometimes, a snowplow truck will pass by and fill in the end of a freshly cleared driveway with snow from the road, which can cause frustration and more work for residents. Please understand that the Borough's top priority is the safety of the traveling public and clearing the roads of snow and ice. Pushing snow onto shoveled pathways is sometimes a consequence of ensuring that roadways are safe for travel. Keep in mind that snowplow trucks usually make one trip to open the road so that residents may get in and out. Then, the truck returns to widen the road and shoulders for future snow accumulation. To effectively clear all the roads in the Borough, trucks do not pick up their blades when passing by driveways and walkways.

## **Why does my street still have snow on it after being plowed?**

Plows push snow rather than digging it from the streets

as shovels do. Depending on the amount of snow that falls, plows may not be able to clear the snow all the way down to the bare asphalt.

## **Why do plows leave snow on the sidewalks, especially at the crosswalks?**

The Borough is aware that snow plowing can create difficulty for sidewalk clearance, especially at the corners. We work with plow drivers to reduce this situation as much as possible, but based on the volume of snow that accumulates, sidewalk corners may pile up in the same way the bottoms of driveways do. Residents may need to use salt and metal shovels if the snow becomes packed down. Residents should also be considerate when clearing snow and ice alongside sidewalk and crosswalk ramps and bus stops.

## **What needs to be considered when shoveling driveways and sidewalks?**

Property owners and snow removal contractors should be aware that plowing snow from private property onto or across public roads or sidewalks is illegal because it can present a serious traffic hazard to motorists. It is unlawful to deposit any snow from your sidewalk or driveway into the roadway. If there is a fire hydrant next to the sidewalk, please:

- Remove all snow and ice from the hydrant
- Make a path wide enough (about 3 feet) around the hydrant for firefighters to work
- Clear a path from the hydrant to the street

## **Who do I contact if my street isn't plowed within 24 hours of snowfall?**

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# Resale Use & Occupancy Highlight

## Thinking of Selling Your Home? Here's What to Expect from the Borough's Resale Inspection Requirement.

If you're getting ready to sell your home in North Wales Borough, be sure to obtain a **Residential Resale Use and Occupancy Permit**. This required step helps confirm your home is safe and meets local maintenance codes before changing ownership.

### What Is the Resale Use and Occupancy Program?

This Borough program ensures homes are safe, well-maintained, and code-compliant before sale. The property must pass an inspection before settlement. If issues are found, the seller usually needs to fix them or agree with the buyer on post-sale repairs.

### Key Areas of Inspection

Here's what the Borough will be checking when reviewing your property:

- Exterior & Structures: Must be in good repair and structurally sound.
- House Number: At least 4 inches tall and clearly visible from the street.
- Stairs & Railings: Handrails and guardrails required for stairs (4+ risers) and decks over 30 inches high.
- Paved Surfaces: Must be safe, intact, and code-compliant. Damaged sidewalks and curbs must be repaired, and missing sidewalks or curbs must be installed.
- Yard Maintenance: Weeds must be under 10 inches; yards free of trash and debris.
- Sewer Lateral: Must pass video inspection approved by North Wales Water Authority (215-699-4836).

### What Happens After the Inspection?

If your home passes, you'll receive a **Use and Occupancy Certificate**. If not, a re-inspection is needed after corrections are made. In some cases, a **Conditional Certificate** can be issued, allowing the buyer to complete certain repairs after closing.

### How to Apply

Applications can be downloaded from the Borough website or picked up at Borough Hall. The fee is \$100. Submit your application before scheduling the inspection.

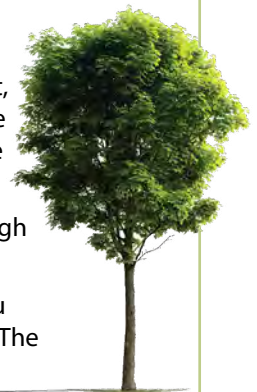
### SHADE TREE COMMISSION

The Shade Tree Commission has the responsibility to advise Borough Council on the planting, replacement, removal, and maintenance of shade trees throughout the Borough. Shade trees include all trees that are within 10 feet of the edge of the paved surface of a street. The Commission issues orders in compliance with Chapter 174 of the North Wales Borough Code.

The Shade Tree Commission holds meetings every 2nd Thursday of the month at 7:00 pm in the Borough Council Room. Meetings are open to the public.



If you wish to trim, remove, or plant any trees within 10 feet of the edge of the street, you are required to submit a Shade Tree Permit to be reviewed by the Shade Tree Commission. # Frequently Asked Questions About the North Wales Historic District

## What is the Historic District?

Established in 2000 by Borough Council, the North Wales Historic Preservation District serves to protect the distinctive architecture that serves as a reminder of the Borough's rich history.

## What is HARB?

The Historical Architectural Review Board (HARB) is a public advisory body created by state and local laws with the purpose of protecting the distinctive and historic character of North Wales Borough by considering the effects of proposed changes to properties within the Historic District and ruling on their appropriateness.

## When does the HARB meet?

The HARB meetings take place the 3rd Wednesday of every month in the Borough Council Room at 7:00 pm. These meetings are open to the public.

## Do I live in the Historic District?

Please view the Historic District Map to determine whether



your property is in the Historic District. The map can be accessed at [www.northwalesborough.org/government/boards-commissions/harb/](http://www.northwalesborough.org/government/boards-commissions/harb/).

## Are there special guidelines for homes in the Historic District?

Properties in the Historic District are subject to special provisions provided under Chapter 130 of the North Wales Borough Code. Exterior alterations may require approval by the HARB. Please contact

Borough staff with any questions or concerns.

## I live in the Historic District, but not in a historic home. Do I still need to follow these guidelines?

All properties in the Historic District are subject to the provisions set in place by HARB, regardless of when they were built. The Historic District was created by Borough Council to preserve the Borough's history as extensively as possible.

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## Protecting Your Water: Understanding Our Annual Water Quality Report And Upcoming Service Line Inventory

At the North Wales Water Authority (NWWA), providing safe, reliable drinking water is our commitment to you. As part of that commitment, we're pleased to announce that our Annual Water Quality Report is now available. This report details the results of rigorous testing conducted throughout the past year and confirms that your drinking water meets or exceeds all state and federal water quality standards.

The Water Quality Report offers a clear and transparent overview of what's in your water, how it's treated, and what steps we take every day to ensure its safety. If you've ever wondered what those terms like "MCL" (Maximum Contaminant Level) or "ppm" (parts per million) really mean, the report provides helpful explanations to guide you through the data.

### Upcoming Service Line Inventory – What It Means For You

In addition to providing clean water today, we're also preparing for new regulations that will further protect water quality in the future. One such requirement under the revised Lead and Copper Rule is a complete inventory of water service line materials.

To comply with these new rules and to better protect public health, NWWA is conducting a system-wide Service Line Inventory to identify the materials used in customer service lines, including those on private property. This important step will help us better understand the presence of lead and galvanized materials in the system and plan for future replacement where necessary.

As we continue this important work, some customers may receive a mailer in the coming months requesting additional information or to schedule a brief inspection. Your continued cooperation is essential as we work toward full compliance with upcoming federal regulations. Please be assured that any fieldwork will be performed by PA-certified water operators from NWWA and every effort will be made to keep any disruptions to a minimum.

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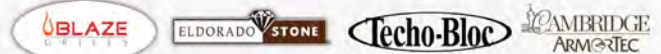
