Member McClure made a motion to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for 203 Shearer Street for roof replacement as presented. Member Neiderhiser seconded the motion. Motion passed 6 yes, 0 no.

Chief Eves discussed a shortage of police officers in general and indicated that he would like to increase the part-time officer's hourly rate to attract more applicants.
