Public Comment

William Kaelin, Emergency Management Coordinator, provided a recap of plowing and snow removal activities pertaining to the most recent snowstorms. He then reviewed a list of snow removal protocols of Public Works and Emergency Management Services. A detailed list was also reviewed on tips for residents and business owners to use as a reference guide when the weather is inclement.

Consideration: Planning Commission Appointment, Term Ending 12/31/2024

Old Business/Committee & Board Reports/Zoning Applications

Manager Hart announced a Zoning Application has been received for 401 Washington Avenue and the hearing will take place on Tuesday, March 2, 2021.

Manager Hart announced the Human Relations Commission (HRC) will be attending mandatory training and will be meeting with representatives from other local HRCs to discuss cooperative endeavors. Member Amato asked if the HRC has reached out to Montgomery County's Human Relations Commission. Manager Hart stated she believes they have not yet contacted the County. Collette D'Angelo, HRC Member, confirmed they had not yet reached out to the County and asked Member Amato if he had any contact information. Member Amato stated he did, and he would share it following the meeting.

Solicitor / Mayor / Council / Chief of Police / Manager

Solicitor Gifford announced that an executive session would take place regarding an update regarding litigation, he also indicated would not require action.

Council thanked Public Works and our Emergency Services for all their assistance with the winter storms.

The MCPC has agreed to extend the current contract to the end of 2021 and will let the Borough know when they have selected a new community planner.
