### **Consideration: Acceptance of Donation from Tex-Mex Connection**

Member Scott made a motion to approve payment of the bills in the amount of \$96,397.81. Member Amato seconded the motion. Motion passed 8 yes, 0 no.

Manager Hart announced that the Borough received one Zoning Hearing Board application for 306 S. Pennsylvania Avenue, which will be reviewed at the next Planning Commission meeting on Thursday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. She also announced that that 215 Church Street will be on the agenda for Planning Commission, as well as the North Wales Borough Comprehensive 2040 Draft Plan.

Solicitor Gifford announced there will be an executive session to discuss one personnel matter in which Council may reconvene and act upon.

Member Amato announced he attended an opioid symposium hosted by Montgomery County and found the information useful. He and other members of Council, including the Mayor will continue to work with outside agencies to explore helping those in our community requiring assistance.
