### **Public Comment**

Liz Ann Iacovetti, 346 W. Walnut Street, expressed concern with vehicles parking too close to the Center Street and W. Walnut Street intersection. Chief Fantry stated he would place warnings on vehicles parking too close to the intersection and he would also consider having the curb line painted yellow to deter future vehicles parking too close.

### **Consideration: Certificate of Appropriateness: 409 S. Main Street**

Manager Hart presented the application and explained that the applicant applied to change the wooden panel in the front door to glass. Member O'Connell asked if the original door will remain. Manager Hart stated it will and only the glass pane will be switched out.

Member Scott made a motion to approve a Certificate of Appropriateness as presented for installation of a large pane of glass to replace the existing wooden panel in the front door. Member McClure seconded the motion. Motion passed 9 yes, 0 no.

Member Little, Jr. expressed his support for the Farm Share Program and encouraged people to participate in the program.

Member Scott made a motion to adjourn. Member Neiderhiser seconded the motion.
