

Residential Parking Permit

Residential parking permits are administered by the North Wales Borough Police Department. Application can be made online or in-person. Applicants seeking a new permit or replacement permit must provide a driver's license and vehicle registration reflecting the Borough property address for which they are applying.

FAQ's

Are residential parking permits available to renters?

Yes, a renter must have an updated driver's license, vehicle registration showing that the rental property address is within North Wales Borough, and a copy of their rental agreement.

When will I receive my permit?

Please allow 5-7 business days for delivery of your parking sticker if you apply online. In person applications are typically fulfilled at the time of application, assuming proper proof of residency is accompanied with the application.

Where do I display my permit?

The sticker shall be placed on the driver side of the rear window. Addresses below in **RED** shall place the sticker on the passenger side of the rear window due to the one-way direction of the street.
