- 3. HRC members stated intentions to follow development of the mayor's plan to increase mental health awareness.
- 4. A working meeting was suggested for January 2022 where a 2022 events calendar would be constructed, establishing tentative dates for tabling and other programming.
- 5. It was decided to cancel the meeting that would occur on December 16th, 2021.
